

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-7

A TEMPORARY RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KINGMAN, KANSAS,
BANNING THE TRAPPING OF CATS.

WHEREAS, it was brought the City's attention that cats are being trapped in the City of Kingman;

WHEREAS, the City Commission is currently reviewing proposed revisions to the City Code and will be addressing this issue within the Code in the near future;

WHEREAS, due to delay and uncertainty caused by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, it would be appropriate for the City to take temporary immediate action on this issue until the revision of the City Code is complete.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF KINGMAN, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution by reference as legislative findings of fact as if expressly set forth herein.

SECTION 2. The trapping of cats is hereby temporarily banned in the City of Kingman.


SECTION 3. Violation of this Resolution shall constitute a class C nonperson misdemeanor with a penalty of up to a \$500.00 fine and/or 30 days in the Kingman County Jail.

SECTION 4. This Resolution take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until June 1, 2020.

Approved and passed by the Governing Body of the City of Kingman, Kansas, this 23rd day of April, 2020.


