
A special meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, July 6, 2020 in the commission room for discussion on the current water issue. Present were Mayor Hacker, Commissioners Harrel, McFarland, Wollen, and Arensdorf. Also present were Manager Graffman, Supt. Robinson, Inspector Archer, and Clerk Conrardy.

Motion made by Harrel, seconded by Arensdorf approve the agenda for the July 6 meeting. Motion declared carried by unanimous vote.

Supt. Robinson went over the events of today. Started Sunday evening when the power plant employees noticed the water levels declining. KWRA and KDHE have been notified. KDHE suggested we hook to the old well system, which is what is happening. KDHE Issued a No Drink Order because the wells are high in nitrate. Testing will be done on Tuesday to see where we are at on nitrates. Attention will be spent on the South Well Field on Tuesday.

Motion made by Arensdorf, seconded by Harrel adopt Resolution 2020-12 declaring a Stage 1 water supply emergency in accordance with Article 6 of Section 15 of the Kingman Municipal Code. Motion declared carried by unanimous vote.

There being no further business motion made by Arensdorf, seconded by Harrel meeting adjourned at 5:32 p.m. Motion declared carried by unanimous vote.
