



# **CITY OF KINGMAN COVID-19 RESIDENTIAL UTILITY RELIEF**

## **PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

The City of Kingman has established the Residential Utility Relief Fund to assist customers that have been financially burdened due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Residential Utility Relief Fund will apply a \$200.00 credit to December utility statements for coverage of utilities from March 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020. Program funds are available through Strengthening People and Revitalizing Kansas (SPARK) funds allocated to Kingman County. Funding is limited and not guaranteed. Only one application per account and per person will be accepted. Priority will be given to those receiving benefits through certain state and federal programs. See application for complete list. Applications may be picked up at Kingman City Hall or downloaded from [cityofkingman.com](http://cityofkingman.com). Applications are due November 20, 2020.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

- Residential customers with utilities provided by the City of Kingman, and,
- Households negatively and financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and such impacts can be documented, and,
- Submit an application with documentation between November 1 and November 20, 2020.

### **Acceptable Basis for Application:**

- Unemployment
- Reduction in work hours
- Quarantine Order
- Positive COVID-19 test
- Missed work to care for someone with COVID-19 diagnosis
- Unexpected or unbudgeted expenses due to COVID-19
- Change in living situation due to COVID-19
- Any other basis related to the pandemic that has caused economic hardship.
- Must provide documentation. Call the City of Kingman for questions, 620-532-3111.

**City of Kingman Utility Customers may be eligible for up to \$200 in credit on their December utility statements.**
