



**PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS**, April 11, 2021, marked the 53<sup>rd</sup> anniversary of the passage of the U.S. Fair Housing Act, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended, of which Title VIII declared that the law of the land would now guarantee the rights of equal housing opportunity; and

**WHEREAS**, the principle of Fair Housing is not only national law and policy but a fundamental human entitlement; and

**WHEREAS**, barriers that diminish the rights and limit the options of any citizen will ultimately diminish the rights and limit the options of all; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Kingman welcomes this opportunity to acknowledge the importance of fair and equal housing for all people without regard to race, religion, color, age, sex, disability, national origin, ancestry or family status; and


**WHEREAS**, equal housing opportunity is a condition of life in our city that can and should be achieved.
